

**Toronto Paramedic Services (TPS)
Level Two (2) Paramedics
2022 Elective Continuing Medical Education (CME) Option**

As outlined in the attached memo from A/Deputy Chief Leo Tsang, dated February 2, 2022 as a Level 2 Paramedic, you are being given the option of not having to complete the 2022 Elective CME and therefore not being eligible for the 12 hours of lieu time already placed in your lieu bank.

Please read the following carefully.

If you choose to participate in the 2022 Elective CME, you will be required to attend the 2022 Elective CME as approved by the Base Hospital. Failure to complete this CME by December 31, 2022 **will** result in de-activation of your paramedic status by the Base Hospital and the Division will take appropriate action.

If you choose **not** to participate in the 2022 Elective CME, you must complete this form, by signing below, and return it to your Superintendent no later than **February 28, 2022**. If you have completed this form in a previous year, you do not have to complete it again.

By choosing not to participate and signing below, you will **not** be required to complete the 2022 Elective CME. As a result, you will no longer be eligible for the twelve (12) hours of lieu time that was placed in your bank in January, 2022, and the Division will remove the lieu time from your bank.

I understand that, by signing this form, I am choosing **not** to attend the Elective CME and that my level of certification will not be affected.
